Rules for outings

- Allowing outing shall be the sole discretion of hostel warden or it may be had by sanction of an appellate authority.
- > Outing period shall not normally exceed 1 hour.
- > Regular outing for the purpose of tuitions will be allowed -
- > On producing a letter of acknowledgment by the said institute/person-of the fact that the student is attending his classes, describing the address, contact no and other related details.
- > The tution master shall also take the responsibility of informing the hostel warden incase the student doesn't reach the place in time.
- > Students desirious of availing tuition outing shall wear school uniform/ uniform prescribed by school authority.
- > In case of any anomaly found in this regard the benefit shall be revoked.

Guidelines for visitors

- Outsiders are not allowed inside hostel premises.
- Parents will not be allowed to meet their wards on any days except Sundays.
- Nobody except parents and local guardians will be allowed to meet the hostellers.
- Parents may if they so wish take their wards on outings between 10 am 5pm on Sundays and holidays.

General rules

- Any damage to school property will be realized from the occupants/person responsible.
- > Keeping of money, valuable ornaments, gadgets like radio, mobile, i pod, camera etc is strictly prohibited.
- > possession of contrabands will call for severe action. items confiscated will not be returned under any circumstance.
- > Food parcels are not allowed.
- > Nobody shall be allowed to go out of school premises without the permission of the concerned authority.
- Hair cut of hostellers will be done in the hostel by a designated barber.
- > Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited.

- ➤ Hostel routine chart /time table is an integral part of hostel decorum as such any breach of the same will be considered misconduct.
- Weak students recommended for tuitions must attend the tuition classes to be paid for by them.

All rules are irrefutable and final and must be abided in all circumstances. Non adherence will call for severe action.

All hostellers are required to bring/have the following at the time of joining the session.

- Three pairs of kurta pyjama (white).
- Four knee length shorts.
- 1 pair each of school shoes, sports shoes, canvas shoes, sandals, slippers.
- 2 sets of school uniform.
- 2 colored dresses. Excess will be confiscated.
- 1 bucket, mug, toilet soap, washing bar, tooth brush, tooth paste, hair oil, comb, mirror etc.
- Towel, quilt/blanket
- Stationery.
