(Each award of ₹ 5000)*

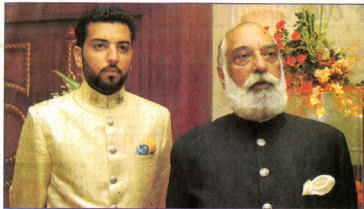

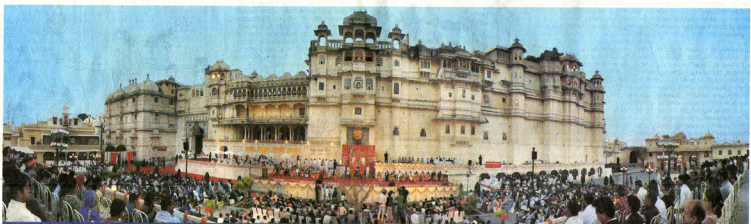
